| intimidating | <i>onieśmielający/przerażający</i> | Some strong and independent women are intimidating for men. |
| rise to the occasion | <i>stanąć na wysokości zadania</i> | If you are a real man, you must rise to the occasion . |
| name a street after sb | <i>nazwać ulice czyjś imieniem</i> | The street was named after a famous singer – Aretha Franklin. |
